Technology Evaluation Research Assistance

A paid position is available for an RPI undergraduate to help with research **full-time in Summer 2017**. The job is for 40 hours per week throughout the summer. The work involves helping collect information about technology and market competition. Work may include academic and trade literature search, report writing, documentation of companies and products, data entry and cleaning, and identification of relevant patents and publications. The data will support joint research in economics and engineering.

Applications are invited from all majors. You must be a continuing RPI undergraduate (sorry, no Master's or Ph.D. students). The position is not compatible with summer courses. It would be helpful for applicants to have skill or experience in one or more of the following areas: literature search and library skills, materials science and engineering knowledge, economics or strategic management knowledge, programming or web-scraping ability, writing and editing skills.
